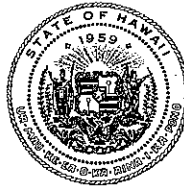

Re: Queen Kaahumanu Highway Widening Phase 2 Kealakehe Parkway to Keahole Airport Road, Federal Aid Project No. NH-019-1(38) ("Project")

By this letter we notify you that the Department of Transportation ("DOT") hereby rescinds the award of the Project to Goodfellow Bros., Inc., ("GBI") sent on December 5, 2008, and reject its proposal as non-responsive. The rescission and rejection are required by the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH"), Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Hearings Officer's decision on April 3, 2009 (reference Hearing No. PCH 2009-1).

In light of the OAH decision, the DOT's course of action will be to:


1. Reject all proposals based on the OAH Hearings Officer's conclusion that proposals failing to meet the requirements of the RFP in a material respect must be rejected as nonresponsive pursuant to HAR, §3-122-97(b).
2. Cancel the solicitation.
3. Advertise a new solicitation utilizing a competitive sealed proposal procurement process.
4. Appeal the OAH decision.
